### *HOW TO QUALIFY:*

- Must be a low-income senior aged 60 or older
- Have a valid driver's license **or** state issued ID (*must be presented at pick up*)
- Be a resident of Dorchester county

to complete an online application from thru May 25<sup>th</sup>.
